When not FRANK Teaming: Nick is the Victorian Director of the Oaktree Foundation.

Bio: Nick is currently the Victorian Director of the Oaktree Foundation; a youth run international aid and development agency. At 21 years old he manages and facilitates a team of over 120 young people who have fundraised hundreds of thousands of dollars and through Oaktree's programs directly empowered tens of thousands of young people to take action and be leaders of change across the state.

A regular week involves public speaking at a conference, designing innovative ways to engage with schools, running training on project management and negotiating sponsorship with corporate supporters.

Originally from the regional Victorian town of Bendigo, Nick moved to Melbourne to study Law/Arts (Politics/Philosophy) at Monash University in 2006 and has since done everything from political lobbying to operating his own business as a consultant and facilitator. He currently sits on the board of award winning environmental education organisation OzGREEN, and is heavily involved in university and faculty leadership programs.

Bio: Simon is an expert in management of major cause-related and community education initiatives.

Simon is currently the General Manager of the Global Poverty Project; a project that will catalyse the international movement to end extreme poverty by creating a 90 minute feature slideshow that clearly but deeply communicates the challenges and opportunities of extreme poverty, and what can be done about it.

Simon was Chief Operations Officer of the Oaktree Foundation from 2006-2008, and before this, he established Oaktree's community education program, Oaktree Interaction, creating and facilitating interactive workshops and presentations with school, university and corporate audiences across the country.

Simon was online events coordinator and a board member at youth media and arts organisation Vibewire from 2004-2006. Simon has consulted to government, corporates including Microsoft and Coca-Cola, and community groups in Australia and overseas on youth matters.

In 2007, Simon presented at the World Economic Forum in Davos, the High Level Conference on Education in Brussels, and facilitated at the Clinton Global Initiative in New York on innovative ways for public-private partnerships to achieve the UN's Education for All goals.

He holds a Bachelor of Arts and a Master of Development Studies, both with First Class Honours from the University of Melbourne.
