Northern Beaches Business Education Network is a non-profit organisation that seeks to assist young people aged 13-19 years with better career choices and planning. They are classified as a Local Community Partnership (LCP) as part of the federal government's Career Advice Australia initiative. NBBEN works with all secondary schools in the Northern Beaches and Lower North Shore areas of Sydney to assist and support the great work already being done in schools.

NBBEN approached The FRANK Team to run our one hour career and entrepreneurship programs in schools in their area, within the scope of Career and Transition Support Services; one of the three key programs/services that LCPs carry out. This was to help ensure that students in their area are provided with a range of careers material to encourage and educate them to be fully aware of their career and employment options. NBBEN also realise the benefits in using various presenters to keep career programs interesting and different for the students, and so have asked The Frank Team to assist.
